As a Surgery our Care Navigation goal is to ensure that each patient is able to communicate with the appropriate clinician within a suitable time frame. Our multi skilled team are able to support and ease GP pressures and increase overall capacity within Primary Care. Care Navigation enables our GPs to concentrate on on-going or complex issues whilst supporting our clinical team. This means that even if you are booked in to see an alternative clinician they may be involved in your care by being invited into your appointment.

COVID-19 vaccine status

Proof of your vaccination status is available via the NHSapp which is downloadable via your app store. Alternatively, please contact the NHS helpline on 119 and ask for a confirmation letter to be sent via post. Please do not contact NHS England for at least 5 days after you've completed your course of vaccines, the letter may also take an additional 5 days to reach you.



COVID-19

We have noticed a significant increase in positive COVID-19 test results in the St Ives area. **Please ensure that you continue to follow the guidance on self-isolation and testing.** If symptomatic (even if you have been vaccinated) please book a PCR test (not lateral flow) via 119 or the Government website. The new variant may present the following symptoms...

- Headache
- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Fever
- Cough
- Loss of sense of smell

To help understand more about COVID-19 symptoms we recommend downloading the "Zoe COVID Symptom Study App" from your app store.

Due to the increase in positive COVID-19 test results locally we were unable to open the Waiting Room to patients and increase bookable face-to-face appointments with our clinicians on Monday 21st June, as previously planned. Our current safety measures such as telephone triage will continue until it is safe for restrictions to ease.
